

November Block

NOV 2025 BLOCK OF THE MONTH PURLED OPENWORK

Finished Size: 9" wide x 9" high. US 9 needle & Medium Washable yarn.

Note: All stitches (except borders) are purls. Row 2 is all P2tog (no yarn-overs!). Row 3 adds the stitches back in a purl make-one.

Cast On 37 stitches (or as many as needed to obtain 9"). Pattern is multiples of 2 + 1, plus 6 sts for side borders

Bottom Border: Knit 4 rows Garter Stitch.

Pattern as follows:

	BORDER	PATTERN	BORDER
	(3 sts)	(multiples of $2 + 1 = 31$ sts)	(3 sts)
Row 1	P1, K2	Purl	К3
Row 2	P1, K2	*P2tog* repeat to last st, P1	К3
Row 3	P1, K2	P1, *purl thru horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and the next st, P1*	К3
Row 4	P1, K2	P1, *YO, P2tog*, repeat *to*	К3

Repeat these 4 rows until block measures about 8-1/2 inches. (I did 13)

Top Border: Knit 4 rows Garter Stitch. Bind off loosely.

Yarn: Lana Grossa Setasuri with Clear Beads







Used needle size 2, knit from bottom up, arms in tubes, joined and gradually changed yarn to a lighter color, then a lace pattern, icord bind off at neck and at bottom edging.


