

Crochet for Knitters

Edie will bust some crochet myths. She will show you some of the many ways you can incorporate crochet into your yarn-y life (even if you never want to crochet a granny square).

Supplies and Homework Optional

This is a presentation more than a hands-on class; the following is optional:

- Knitted swatch of any size
- Yarn used to knit the swatch
- •Crochet hook in a size appropriate for the yarn (probably 1 size larger than you used for the swatch, so if you knit with a 5 mm needle, grab a 5.5 mm hook)

December Block

DEC 2025 BLOCK OF THE MONTH CHECKERBOARD

Finished Size: 9" wide x 9" high. US 9 needle & Medium Washable yarn.

Cast On 36 stitches (or as many as needed to obtain 9"). Pattern is multiples of 5, plus 6 sts for side borders

Bottom Border: Knit 4 rows Garter Stitch.

Pattern as follows:

	BORDER	PATTERN	BORDER
	(3 sts)	(multiples of $5 = 30$ sts)	(3 sts)
Rows 1-8	P1, K2	*K5, P5*, repeat 2 more times	КЗ
Rows 11-16	P1. K2	*P5, K5* repeat 2 more times	К3

Repeat these 16 rows until block measures about 8-1/2 inches. (I did 3 repeats, total of 8 squares))

Top Border: Knit 4 rows Garter Stitch. Bind off loosely.
