

## **Supplies and Homework Optional**

- Knitted swatch of any size
- Yarn used to knit the swatch
- Crochet hook in a size appropriate for the yarn (probably 1 size larger than you used for the swatch, so if you knit with a 5 mm needle, grab a 5.5 mm hook)

## January Block

### JANUARY 2026 BLOCK OF THE MONTH BAMBOO RIB

Finished Size: 9" wide x 9" high. US 9 needle & Medium Washable yarn.  
Cast On 37 stitches. Pattern is multiples of 6 + 1, plus 6 for borders

**Bottom Border:** Knit 4 rows

**Pattern as follows:**

	BORDER (3 sts)	PATTERN (31 sts)	BORDER (3 sts)
<b>Row 1 (RS)</b>	p1, k2,	<b>P1, (K2, P1) 10 times</b>	K3
Row 2	p1, k2	(K1 P2) 10 times, K1	K3
<b>Row 3</b>	<b>P1, k2</b>	<b>P1, (K2, P4) 5 times</b>	K3
Row 4	p1, k2	(K4, P2) 5 times, K1	K3
<b>Row 5</b>	<b>P1, k2</b>	<b>P1, (K2, P1) 10 times</b>	K3
Row 6	p1, k2	(K1 P2) 10 times, K1	K3
<b>Row 7</b>	<b>P1, k2</b>	<b>P1, (K2, P1) 10 times</b>	K3
Row 8	p1, k2	(K1 P2) 10 times, K1	K3
<b>Row 9</b>	<b>P1, K2</b>	<b>P1, (P3, K2, P1) 5 times</b>	K3
Row 10	p1, k2	(K1, P2, K3) 5 times, K1	K3
<b>Row 11</b>	<b>P1, K2</b>	<b>P1, (K2, P1) 10 times</b>	K3
Row 12	p1, k2	(K1 P2) 10 times, K1	K3

Repeat pattern until block measures about 8-1/2 inches.

**Top Border:** Knit 4 rows Garter Stitch. Bind off loosely
